**ABOUT THE AUTHOR...**  
**Madeleine L'Engle**  
Born on November 29, 1918, in New York City, author Madeleine L'Engle is best known for such novels as *A Wrinkle in Time* (1962) and *A Wrinkle in Time* (1975). She was the only child of Charles Wadsworth and Madeleine Sophie Camp, a writer and artist.

Madeleine L'Engle began writing at a young age, producing her first story when she was only five years old. At the age of 12, L'Engle moved with her parents to Europe and was enrolled in a Swiss boarding school. She returned to the United States a few years later and attended Ashley Hall, a boarding school in South Carolina. When she was 17, L'Engle lost her father a soldier in WWII.

After earning her college degree, Madeleine moved to New York City. She found work in the theater as a writer and continued her writing career. She published her first two novels, *The Small Rain* and *Clea*.


Even though her first novels weren't highly successful, it was at this time that she married actor Hugh Fossell in 1946. The couple had two children together, daughter Josephine and son Sam. They later adopted another child, daughter Mada.

In 1947 L'Engle decided to start writing children's novels. After years of struggling to find her niche in writing, she wrote *A Wrinkle in Time* in 1962, a Newbery Award Winner.
