#### About the Author... Madeline L'Engle

Born on November 29, 1918, in New York City, author Madeline L'Engle is best known for such novels as *A Wrinkle in Time* (1962) and *A Windy Thing* (1978). She was the only child of Charles Woodsworth and Madeline Bennett Camp, a writer and pianist.

Madeline L'Engle began writing at a young age, producing her first story when she was only five years old. At the age of 12, L'Engle moved with her parents to Europe and was enrolled in a girls' boarding school. She returned to the United States a few years later and attended Ashley Hall, a boarding school in South Carolina. When she was 17, L'Engle left her father's side in Paris.

After earning her college degree, Madeline moved to New York City. She found work in the theater as a writer and continued her writing career. She published her first two novels, *The Small Rain* and *Cla*.

Even though her first novels weren't highly successful, it was at this time that she married actor Hugh Franklin. The couple had two children together, daughter Josephine and son, Ron. They later adopted another child, daughter Maja.

In 1961, L'Engle decided to start writing children's novels. After years of struggling to find her niche in writing, she wrote *A Wrinkle in Time* in 1962, a Newbery Award winner.



